## Green Public Financial Management

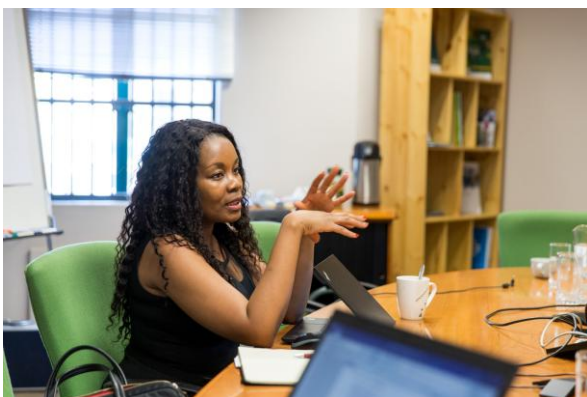
### Why does it matter?

Green Public Financial Management (Green PFM) is critical for **enabling the integration of climate and environmental objectives** into public expenditures and incentives. As countries face increasing climate risks and rising demands for climate finance, public financial management systems must evolve to ensure that climate policies are fiscally sustainable, transparent, and effective.

Strengthening Green PFM capacities allows governments to:

- Manage climate-related fiscal risks and integrate them into fiscal frameworks.
- Mobilize and allocate climate finance more effectively and transparently.
- Track and report climate-related public expenditures.
- Support green transformation policies while maintaining fiscal discipline.

Ultimately, Green PFM **ensures that climate and development objectives** are delivered through sound fiscal governance.



### What is the focus?

Strengthening the capacity of public finance institutions to **design, implement, and monitor climate-responsive fiscal policies and budgets** targeting officials from Ministries of Finance, Planning and line ministries, public investment planners and budget officers and technical advisors involved in fiscal policy and climate finance. The materials enable participants to develop country-specific Green PFM training programmes for continued national capacity development.
